

# LYON COUNTY TILE CROSSING PERMIT

Lyon County agrees to pay for all tile costs to cross the road right-of-way provided:

1. The permit is signed by all landowners.
2. The tile line crosses the right of way and connects to a functioning tile.
3. The County reserves the right to approve or reject the method of crossing, tile materials, and tile size. **Tile material shall be FDR26 or better.**
4. Soil Conservation Service must be notified of crossing.
5. Tile Crossing Permit to be submitted at least 48 hours before crossing is to be installed.
6. Payment will not be made by Lyon County for crossing placed without proper notification. **Please make sure to notify the Engineer's Office before the actual work is done on any County road. Phone 712-472-8230.**
7. Contractor will be responsible for properly backfilling and tamping tile crossing to avoid excessive settling.
8. In the event Lyon County is called out to repair crossings due to poor workmanship, contractor will be assessed cost of repairs.
9. Tiling contractor is responsible for proper traffic control while crossing right of way according to the MUTCD.
10. **All crossings on gravel roads between October 1 and May 1 shall be bored with the cost to be split 50% County and 50% landowner.**
11. **If crossing a hard surfaced road, please submit two (2) quotes for the tile crossing.**
